It is encouraging to note that the Government of Venezuela has taken steps to comply with the decisions of the 343<sup>rd</sup>, 344<sup>th</sup> and 345<sup>th</sup> Sessions of the Governing Body.

We take note of Director General's report on the second Social Dialogue Forum and recognize the Venezuela Government's continuous engagement and cooperation with the ILO to achieve meaningful progress.
