



OIC Statement during the ID on High Commissioner's annual report
62nd HRC Session
16 June 2026

Mr. President,

We thank the High Commissioner for the update.

The OIC Group remains gravely concerned by the worsening situation in the Occupied Palestinian Territory, where the occupying power is perpetrating a genocide in a climate of impunity marked by complete absence of accountability.

The OIC categorically condemns all crimes perpetrated by the Israeli Occupation Forces and demands the establishment of a sovereign, independent, contiguous Palestinian state on the 1967 lines with East Jerusalem as its capital.

In Lebanon, we call for an immediate and unconditional ceasefire, the full withdrawal of Israeli forces, complete respect for Lebanon's sovereignty and territorial integrity. We also call for safe return of displaced populations and the reconstruction of destroyed areas, particularly in the South of Lebanon.

Mr. President,

The human rights situation in Indian Occupied Jammu and Kashmir remains a matter of deep anguish. We call on India to fully comply with the relevant UNSC resolutions and address human rights concerns reflected in the two OHCHR's Kashmir reports.

Mr. President,

The scale of plight and suffering of Rohingya people is deeply troubling. It is imperative that the international community make concerted efforts for securing justice for them.

Lastly, as the conflict in the Sudan continues to cause immense suffering on civilians, we urge all parties to cease hostilities and commit to a durable peace.
